Range:



The Chevy Bolt (which costs less than 30k new) has a range of 238 miles per charge.

Charging Speed:

Rapid charging points are available for lots of cars like the BMW i3 or Nissan Leaf and can give you up to 80% charge in as little as 30 minutes.



Cost:



The Hyundai IONIQ is less than 23k after tax credits.

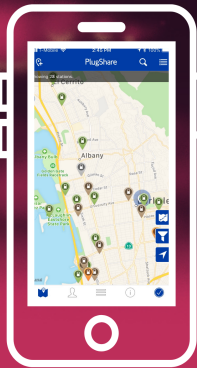
